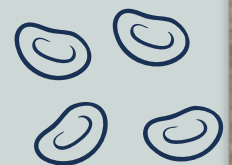
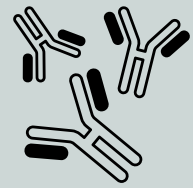
About Milan, Italy
