Speaker Guidelines

- Each speaker should plan a 25-minute presentation, followed by a 5-minute question period.
- English would be the preferred language for the presentation, and with advance notice, we can
 - arrange a translator.
- Presentation needs to be submitted in pdf format and in readable format Limit file size to of presentation 30MB or less. Label your presentation with First name & last name.
 Submit your presentation at least 15 days before the conference to
- <u>emergencymedicine@mindspaceconferences.uk</u>, also suggest you carry your presentation on a Hard disk or pen drive.
- Equipment is available in the meeting room digital projector, screen, laptop, slider with pointer, mike, and basic sound system.

Certification

Poster presentation Guidelines.

- Poster presentation size need to be in 1.2 meters high by 1.8 meters wide.
- All the poster presentation needs to mount on the walls 1 hour prior to the start time of poster sessions as per the final program.
